Thank you for your interest in the YMCA Calgary Peace Medals. Please read the nomination criteria carefully before submitting your nomination form (below).

1. Nominees must reside within a 100km radius of Calgary, and have conducted their peace work between October 2008 and October 2010.
2. Nominees in the International categories should have conducted work that primarily benefitted people around the world. Nominees in the Community categories should have conducted work that primarily benefitted people locally. Youth nominees should be aged 18 or younger.
3. Nominations will be judged solely on the information provided by the nominator.
4. The deadline for nominations is October 1, 2010.
