## //PROTOCOL

Key YMCA staff are provided with appropriate instruction on EpiPen use if a child experiences Anaphylaxis.

When responding to a severe allergic reaction:

- Dial (9) – 9-1-1 to contact Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
- Staff will confirm that the EpiPen has been prescribed to the patient and has not reached its expiration date.
- If the child has an EpiPen, direct child to use the EpiPen as per directions from the EMS dispatcher. If the child is unable to use the EpiPen, trained YMCA staff will administer the EpiPen as per directions from EMS dispatcher
- Record time of EpiPen administration
- Comfort child
- Provide any additional care that may be required until EMS arrives
- Contact parent/guardian and/or emergency contact
